INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

General: Polish Journal of Agronomy covers topics connected to broad-sense crop production and agriculture-related environmental issues. It accepts original research papers and invited review articles.

The manuscript of original paper should not exceed 12 pages (review article – up to 18 pages), with the following sequence: Title (with the running title attached), Name(s), Postal and e-mail address of the author(s), Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Materials and methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, References.

Text: A4 format page with all 2.5 cm margins, MS Word, Times New Roman font, 12 p., 1.5 spaced.

Tables: should be self explanatory, MS Word, Times New Roman font, 10 p. **Graphs:** MS Excel

Photographs and drawings: no less than 300 dpi resolution, TIFF or JPEG format All figures (photographs, drawings, graphs) should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper.

References: in alphabetical order, each in right sequence acc. to examples below *articles from science journals*
